Together as a family, we planted our 10-acre vineyard in the Stags Leap District's characteristic volcanic soil on our hands and knees in 1980. Our family's consistent hard work since then has yielded some pretty amazing fruit, which we work to make sure shines through in our wines. Stags Leap District has perfect conditions for Cabernet, but we ventured north into Rutherford for our Sauvignon Blanc fruit grown on a Musque clone. Our Sauvignon Blanc is a balanced expression of our winemaker's skill and the quality Rutherford fruit that is evident in the finished product. We have named this wine *Nouvelle Génération*, which translates into "Rising Generation." It celebrates the up and coming children of the Taylor Family and the new generation of wine consumers. This wine is fresh and spirited, just like our family's "Rising Generation."

Our Wine

Our 2008 Sauvignon Blanc greets you with pink grapefruit, white fig and tropical scents. This distinctive wine is bright with lively aromas, flavors and acidity. It was barrel fermented on neutral French Oak for a hint of softness while maintaining its crisp, delicate characteristics. Serve with Dry Jack and Peppercorn cheese or fish tacos.
