Our Roots

We're not like most other Napa Valley wineries. We're not concerned with being flashy and slick. We focus on two all-important basics: family and quality and we strive to pass these values into our wines.

We like to make our wines like we live our lives – in balance. Our number one priority is family. Together as a family, we planted our 10-acre vineyard in the Stags Leap District's characteristic volcanic soil on our hands and knees in 1980. Our family's consistent hard work since then has yielded some pretty amazing fruit, which we work to make sure shines through in our wines. Stags Leap District has perfect conditions for Cabernet, but we ventured to the east into Chiles Valley for our Sauvignon Blanc fruit grown on a Musque clone. Our Sauvignon Blanc is a balanced expression of our winemaker's skill and the quality Chiles Valley fruit that is evident in the finished product. We have named this wine *Nouvelle Génération*, which translates into "Rising Generation." It celebrates the up and coming children of the Taylor Family. This wine is fresh and spirited, just like our family's "Rising Generation."

Our Wine

Our 2007 Sauvignon Blanc greets you with grapefruit, pineapple and delicate notes of nectarine. This distinctive wine is bright with lively aromas, flavors and acidity. It was barrel fermented on neutral French Oak and then returned to stainless steel after fermentation to preserve its crisp, delicate characteristics. Serve with broiled oysters topped with Jalapeno Monterey Jack Cheese
